Mr. Schab updated Council and the Planning Commission on the Access Control Plan for Wilmington Pike prepared by the Transportation Coordinating Committee and the Wilmington Pike Task Force. The study includes Wilmington Pike from Brown Road to Bellmeade Drive in Bellbrook. Mr. Schab reviewed proposed street relocations and the relocation of Wilmington Pike south of Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road. Both Council and the Planning Commission concurred with the Plan, no objections were offered.

Mr. Reynolds reviewed the existing and proposed location for Normandy Lane and three alternatives for it's location at the intersection of State Route 725 and Normandy Lane. What happens is out of the hands of the City of Centerville but of great concern to the City, it may not conform to the Thoroughfare Plan. Discussion followed concerning cul-de-sacing Normandy Lane where it intersects Franklin Street. The immediate area of Normandy Lane and State Route 725 will be detailed by the City Staff for further consideration.

Mr. Reynolds reviewed the present status of the proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment. A rough draft was distributed, the Staff will begin to refine this legislation for Planning Commission and Council's consideration.

Mr. Farquhar reviewed for Planning Commission and Council a proposed Ordinance which would change the powers of the Planning Commission relative to granting Variances to the Zoning Ordinance. It eliminates the authority to grant a Variance for a use otherwise permitted in another zoned district.
