Council interviewed Parks and Recreation Board Applicant James Bramlage. Council concurred that said appointment be made.

Council interviewed Sister City Committee Applicant Ernest Vines. Council concurred with said appointment pending Mr. McQueeney's discussion with the Chairman of the Sister City Committee. Will have confirmation Tuesday, November 25, 1975.

Mr. Kenning briefly reviewed the inquiries made to get outside funding for the engineering study needed for the Clyo Road extension. It appears that the City will have to fund this study out of current revenues. Council agreed that this matter should be reviewed and prioritized as part of the Budget review. Several Councilmen indicated that this item must be done.

Mr. Kenning briefly reviewed the status of the Montgomery County Solid Waste Management Plan. It was noted that Centerville is the only City that has not signed or authorized signing of the Contract. After discussion, Council directed the City Manager to prepare a revised Contract for their consideration. Each Councilman was asked to forward additional items which they believe should be included in the Contract.

Mayor Hoy assigned the 1976 Budget to the Council Finance Committee for review and recommendation to Council.

A discussion was held concerning the proposed Citizen Tax Committee, various potential taxes, the fairness of various types of taxes, at what point should a tax committee be formed, and the policy role of Council. It was the consensus of Council that the establishment of the Committee be deferred until after Council reviews and makes a decision on potential taxes.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
