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SPECIAL MEETING

The Council of the City of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio met in Special Session on Friday. July 6, 1973 at 12:00 noon at the Centerville Municipal Building. The Meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag with Deputy-Mayor John McIntire presiding. Councilmen present were as follows: John Davis, J. V. Stone, Russell Sweetman, Leonard Stubbs, Charles McQueeney, City Manager James Smith, Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar, City Engineer Karl Schab and Clerk of Council Marilyn McLaughlin.

Mr. Farquhar reviewed proposed Resolution Number 21-73, a Resolution declaring it necessary to improve East Franklin Street and assess abutting property owners on a benefit basis. As questioned by Mr. Sweetman, Mr. Farquhar advised that both sides of East Franklin Street will be improved, assessment to be over a ten year period. The assessment includes Bonding, Interest, advertising expense and legal expense. Mr. Schab advised that the length of sidewalk as stated in the Resolution should be changed from 1550 to 1344 feet. The Resolution was changed to incorporate the City Engineer's suggestion. Mr. Stone sponsored Resolution Number 21-73, A Resolution Declaring It Necessary To Improve East Franklin Street In The City Of Centerville, Ohio, By Widening The Said Street And Lowering The Crown Thereof From A Point 2800 Feet West Of Clyo Road To A Point Approximately 1900 Feet West Of Clyo Road (A Distance Of Approximately 900 Feet), Including The Installation Of Curbs, Gutters, And Approximately 310 Feet Of Storm Sewers, And Installation Of Concrete Sidewalk On The North Side Of Said Street From A Point 1950 Feet West Of Clyo Road To Clyo Road (Comprising Approximately 1344 Feet Of Sidewalk Four Feet Wide), and moved that it be passed, as amended. Mr. Sweetman second-A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor ed the motion. of the motion.

There being no further business, the Meeting was, adjourned.
