City Manager reviewed Centerville Parks today & future parks for the City. He proposes a swimming pool along Cho Road, east side (Black Oak). Advised of City hiring a full time Recreation Director. - full time recreational leadership, all year round. City could provide additional equipment.

Mayor advised of Council's consensus that perhaps a Recreation Commission should be established made of Centerville Citizens. Better representation to residents of Centerville. Mayor suggested that parks be acquired from Park District for a dollar a park on 99 year lease.

Park District organized - Volunteers, appointed by Common Pleas Court, for three year periods, no compensation.

Park District is willing to cooperate as long as they do not lose their identity in the entire community.
