Proposed Services for future of Centerville:

Sweetman - Industrial Waste Collection, Leaf Pick Up,

Green - Install Street lights in critical places, periodically make survey. Traffic light at Marshall & Whipp.

Buy equipment for Parks in conjunction with Park Board in City Parks. White lines along edge of certain streets. One Police Officer to teach Bicycle Safety in Schools.

McIntire - Sidewalk snow removal, Pick up large appliances and dispose of same. Waste collection return and pick up at house, possiblyushman carts. Pick up of tree branches.

Stone - Explore possibility of painting curbs white or fluorescent to ident. of streets at radius points, possibly this could take the place of some street lights. Wondered about licensing bicycles, so they would be properly equipped, and safety rules could be stressed. Consider employing a mechanic for preventive maintenance. Quarterly financial reports to citizens thru publicity. Consider Adult Programs in Recreation. Encourage Township to widen Marshall Road.

Zengel - Sweep streets more often.

Stubbs - Purchase mulcher & sell mulch back to citizens or give it back.
