The Council of the City of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio met in Special Session, Friday, January 2, 1970 at 8:00 P.M. at the Municipal Building with Mayor Paul Hoy presiding. Councilmen elect Victor A. Green, John W. McIntire, Jr., John A. Davis, and J.V. Stone were sworn into office by Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar. Others in attendance were Councilmen Harold Wells and John Zengel, City Manager John Griffin, Engineer Frank Williams, and Clerk of Council Marilyn McLaughlin.

The Police Contract between the City of Centerville and Washington Township for 1970 was discussed. Council agreed to enter into a contract with Washington Township to provide for the extension of the previous contract on a day to day basis, not to exceed 30 days, during which time a new contract for \$125,000.00 will be signed and the \$6,000.00 difference be placed in arbitration and a binding formula worked out within 90 days to be used for future contracts. Said temporary contract would provide the Township with Centerville Police Protection until a permanent one year Contract can be signed by both parties. Mr. Farquhar reviewed an Emergency Ordinance to provide authorization of this temporary contract. Mr. Zengel sponsored Ordinance Number 1-70: An Emergency Ordinance Authorizing A Temporary Contract With the Board Of Township Trustees Of Washington Township To Provide For The Extension Of The Previous Contract Which Expired December 31, 1969 To Provide Police Protection To The Township On a Day To Day Basis, and moved for it's adoption. Mr. Stone seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.

The Meeting was then adjourned.
