Purpose of Meeting = Presentation of Income Tax  
For March 17, 1970 Review.

1970 - Show current receipts

Show current expenditures

then show what Income Tax will provide

Make one chart showing listing on Notice to  
taxpayers - pie wedges would be excellent.

Show only amounts received in property tax  
and how it is received, and how much per.

Make figures larger so can be seen from rear of room.

1971 - Under Capital Expenses just note amounts on  
highest items, just list the other items w/  
grand total.

Important not to show a surplus, use all dollars.

Total Expenses should read Total Commitments

1972 - Place most important Capital Expenses on top, ones of most importance to residents.

Exclude Bond Monies from receipt monies, should only include receipts from Current & Income Tax.

Minimize emphasis on Municipal Center & Civic Center, & Library, delete.

Public should be made aware of what this Income tax will mean. Who will be paying & how much.

Dick should review Ordinances, & direct it to the audience.

Ron should expand on Fiscal questions & presentation of status.

Wind up presentation with a repeat of the need.

Show as well as Street Repair, improved police protection, other improvements throughout City, for safety purposes.

make expenses = receipts with very little carry over.

Show how little is being received through property tax.
