The Public Hearing on Ordinance Number 9-69: An Ordinance To Adopt The Uniform Building Code of Montgomery County, Ohio, As Amended, By Reference, Under The Provisions Of Section 5.06 City Charter And Adopting Inspection Fees, was held. The fees were discussed by Council. Mayor Hoy recommended that Centerville retain the Montgomery County fees. Council agreed with this recommendation and agreed to review the fees at the end of every year.
