The Council of the City of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio, met in Special Session, Tuesday, March 11, 1969 at 9:00 P.M. at the Municipal Building with Mayor Paul Hoy presiding. Councilmen present were as follows: Harold Wells, Richard Miller, John McIntire, John Zengel, J.V. Stone, Engineer Frank Williams, Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar, Director of Finance Ronald Budzik, and Clerk of Council Marilyn McLaughlin.

Mr. McIntire sponsored Ordinance Number 19-69: An Ordinance Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Written Contract With Wimsatt-Horvath Construction, Incorporated For Road Work To Be Performed On East Franklin Street In The City, and moved that it be set for Public Hearing on March 24, 1969. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Mr. Williams advised that he has been impressed with the work of this Construction Company. He further advised that George Powell, Street Superintendent has dug holes five feet deep on the north side of East Franklin Street and found only small rocks and Centerville clay, no large amount of rock was found.

Mayor Hoy advised that the Board of Education has acted to provide for the Washington Township School District to become the Centerville City School District.

Mr. Williams advised that the site selected for the new fire station is at the north west corner of Irongate Park Drive and Maple Avenue.
