The Council of the City of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio met in Special Session, Thursday, July 31, 1969, at 8:00 P.M. at the Municipal Building with Mayor Paul Hoy presiding. Councilmen present were as follows: Harold Wells, Richard Miller, John Zengel, John McIntire, J. V. Stone, City Manager John Griffin, Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar and Clerk of Council Marilyn McLaughlin.

The purpose of this Meeting was to discuss waste collection in Centerville: the present problems and future plans. Mayor Hoy reviewed the list of recent complaints and the nature of same. Mr. Griffin recommended getting a commitment from Frank Hoffer as to the service he will render in the future.

Municipal Refuse Collection and methods of financing were discussed by Council. City Manager John Griffin distributed a preliminary report on Municipal Refuse Collection. Discussion followed. Council concurred that Municipal Waste Collection should be investigated to the finest detail by the City Manager, Municipal Attorney, and the Director of Finance, and that the City should proceed rapidly.

Mr. Stone suggested that the City investigate a lease purchase agreement, Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar will conduct such an investigation.

In order to correct the present problem of Koogler Refuse Collection, Inc, (that of being behind in pick ups) Council agreed that the City should offer help in anyway it can.

The Meeting was then adjourned.
