
Mr. McClellan seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in four ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Hoy gave Ordinance #3-67 its second reading by title only.



Mr. Davis moved that the third reading of Ordinance #3-67 by title only be accepted and the Ordinance be passed. Mr. McClellan seconded the


motion. A roll call vote resulted in four ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. McIntire advised that the minutes of January 2, 1967 should be amended to read "At the request of the Street Committee, Mayor Hoy recommended to Council that a committee with Mr. Davis as Chairman be set up to study Building Inspection."

Dr. Bruggemann asked that this sign ordinance be pursued diligently. Mayor Hoy advised the proposed ordinance will be presented to the Co-ordinating Committee and Frank Ventura. Copies will be made for Councilmen and Solicitor Fred Young.

Mr. Lyons reported for the Planning Board. He reported the request for a directional sign to the Bellbrook Ski Resort to be erected at Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road and State Route 48 by the Hillcrest Sign Company has been referred to the Board of Zoning Appeals.
