

Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and State of Ohio met in Special Session, Monday, January 18, 1965 at the Town Hall at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor William Gimbel presiding. Councilmen present were, Kenneth McClellan, Richard Knierer, Charles Taylor, Howard Griest, Clarence Stingley, John Theiss and Solicitor William Wiseman.

The minutes of the meeting of January 4, 1965 were read. Mr. Theiss moved that the minutes be accepted as read. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Taylor sponsored Ordinance #3-65, an Annual Appropriation Ordinance. Mr. Taylor moved that Ordinance #3-65 be given the first reading. Mr. McClellan seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance #3-65 its first reading.

Mr. McClellan moved to accept the first reading of Ordinance #3-65. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. McClellan moved that the statutory rules and regulations for reading ordinances on three separate and distinct days be suspended and that Ordinance #3-65 be given its second and third readings by title only. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance #3-65 its second reading by title only.

Mr. Knierer moved that the second reading of Ordinance #3-65 by title only be accepted. Mr. McClellan seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance #3-65 its third reading by title only.

Mr. Knierer moved that the third reading of Ordinance #3-65 by title only be accepted and the Ordinance be passed. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Knierer sponsored Ordinance #4-65 an Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 13-1959 and Ordinance 10-1961 section 2 (a) increasing permit fee required.

Mr. Knierer moved that Ordinance #4-65 be given the first reading. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance #4-65 its first reading.

Mr. Stingley moved to accept the first reading of Ordinance #4-65 as corrected. Mr. Knierer seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. McClellan moved that the statutory rules and regulations for reading Ordinances on three separate and distinct days be suspended and that Ordinance #4-65 be given its second and third readings by title only. Mr. Knierer seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance #4-65 its second reading by title only.

Mr. McClellan moved that the second reading of Ordinance #4-65 by title only be accepted. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance #4-65 its third reading by title only.

Mr. Stingley moved that the third reading of Ordinance #4-65 by title only be accepted and the Ordinance be passed. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel read the Agreement regarding trash collection within the Village, and all amendments thereto. Discussion was held by council. Mr. Taylor moved to accept the low bid of the Engle Trucking Company in regard to trash collection, and that a contract between the Village of Centerville and the Engle Trucking Company be drafted for approval. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Discussion was held by council regarding the Centerville Citizens Planning Advisory Group. Mayor Gimbel appointed Mr. John Zengel as temporary chairman.

The meeting was then adjourned.
