

Special Meeting

The council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio met in special session Thursday, January 21, 1965 at 10:00 P.M. at the Town Hall with Mayor William Gimbel presiding. Councilmen present were John Theiss, Howard Griest, Richard Knierer, Kenneth McClellan, Clarence Stingley and Charles Taylor.

Mr. Taylor moved that the Village of Centerville instruct the Dayton Power and Light Company to remove 16-4,000 Lumen Incandescent Lights and to install 24-11000 lumen Mercury Lights on Existing Wood Poles as soon as possible. Mr. McClellan seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Stingley voted no. Council instructed the clerk to advise Dayton Power & Light Company to proceed.
