The minutes of the meeting of January 18, 1965 were read. Mr. Theiss moved to accept the minutes as read. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

The minutes of the public hearing of January 21, 1965 regarding the request for conditional use--swim club were read. Mr. McClellan moved that the minutes be accepted as read. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Knierer reported for the Street Committee. Mr. Knierer, with recommondation by the Street Committee, made the motion that the Bid for the 1965 resurfacing contract be accepted from the Dayton Asphalt and Paving Company in the amount of \$17,545.00. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Knierer reported that action would be taken to have the contract signed. Mr. Knierer requested that the bid bonds be returned.
