the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and Authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. Mr. Theiss moved to accept this resolution. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

The 1966 Contract between the Village of Centerville and Washington Township was read and discussion was held. Matter tabled until later date.

Mr. Robert Miller appeared before Council as representative for Village South. Mr. Miller advised council that steps are being taken to proceed with improvements in Village South Sections 9 and 10 and in Sections 2 and 4 in connection with Far Hills Avenue and that Bond will be ready by 12/30/65

Mr. Knierer reported for the Street Committee and moved that Lake Glen Section #1 be accepted by the Village and that their Sub-Dividers Agreement and Performance Bond be released upon receipt of a 1 year Maintenance Bond in the amount of \$1,000.00. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Knierer requested deposits be returned on permits # 65-10, 65-11, 65-13.

The meeting was then adjourned.
