

Regular Meeting

The council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and State of Ohio met in regular session Tuesday September 9, 1964 at 7:30 P.M. at the Town Hall with Mayor William Gimbel presiding. Councilmen present were, Kenneth McClellan, Richard Knierer, Charles Taylor, Howard Griest, Clarence Stingley, John Theiss, Solicitor William Wiseman and Engineer Frank Williams.

The minutes of the meeting of July 6, 1964 were read. Mr. Taylor moved that the minutes be approved as corrected. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in four ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. McClellan and Mr. Theiss abstained.

The minutes of the July 16, 1964 meeting were read. Mr. McClellan moved that the minutes be approved as read. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Theiss abstained.

The minutes of the August 3, 1964 meeting were read. Mr. Theiss moved that the minutes be approved as read. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Griest abstained.

The minutes of the August 10, 1964 meeting were read. Mr. McClellan moved that the minutes be approved as read. Mr. Theiss seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Griest abstained.

Mr. Gimbel gave the Mayors report as follows:

Mr. Theiss moved that the Mayors report be accepted as given. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel requested that the <sup>POLICE</sup> ~~Street~~ Committee make an inspection of the streets near Westerly Drive to determine if "no Parking" signs should be erected. This request was made regarding a letter received by the Mayor from Mr. Richard Brenberger on Westerly Drive, Centerville, Ohio.

Mayor Gimbel gave the Police Committee report for the month of August.

Mr. Taylor reported for the Finance Committee. Mr. Taylor moved that vouchers #389 through #445 as approved by the Finance Committee be paid, Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Knierer reported for the Street Committee. Mr. Knierer reported that three bids had been received in regard to the purchase of a 1965 truck. Mr. Knierer moved that bid be accepted from the International Harvester Company for the truck cab only in the amount of \$2955.51, and that the bid from the Miami Valley Trucking Equipment Company for the body only be accepted in the amount of \$799.00, and that the bid bond be returned to Stueve Ford. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted

in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Knierer read letter received from Engineer Frank Williams regarding Berkshire Sub-Division. Mr. Knierer moved to release the bond on Berkshire Sub-Division. Mr. Stingley seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Theiss reported for the Planning Board.

Mayor Gimbel read Sub-Dividers Agreement and Performance Bond for Wispwood Estates. Mr. Theiss moved that the Sub-Dividers Agreement and Performance Bond be approved as read and corrected. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion. A check in the amount of \$409.80 was received by the Village for inspection fees.

Mayor Gimbel read Sub-Dividers Agreement and Performance Bond for Concept #3, Section #11. Mr. Griest moved that the Sub-Dividers Agreement and Performance Bond be accepted as corrected. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion. A check in the amount of \$570.00 was received by the Village from Concept for inspection fees.

Mr. Wiseman was instructed to publish Notice of Sale of Municipal Building Bonds in the Dayton Daily News. The date of opening is to be October 5, 1964 at 12:00 Noon at the Town Hall bids to be received by the clerk.

The meeting was then adjourned.
