SPECIAL MEETING

A plat plan of Concept Plat #3 was presented to the council for consideration and recommendation relative to the general street lay out.

Mayor Gimbel announced that a fourth patrolman had been hired. The new MARCH patrolman would start work April 1, 1962.

After discussion of the need for a street thoroughfare plan, the council authorized the village engineer to lay out a street thoroughfare plan for the newly annexed areas.

The council discussed the three requests for rezoning, which were submitted to council at the previous meeting, and the desirability of a public hearing relative to the requests. Action was deferred until a later meeting.

The council received a letter from the village engineer outlining proposed reduction in performance bond on Pleasant Hills plat. The letter was given to the Street Committee for consideration.

Plans for a Municipal Building were briefly reviewed by the council.
