

Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio, met in special session with Mayor William Gimbel presiding, March 21, 1962 at 7:30 P.M. Present were councilmen John Theiss, Richard Knierer, Wilbur Sims, Howard Griest and John Zengel and solicitor William Wiseman.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read. Mr. Griest moved that the minutes be approved as read. Mr. Knierer seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in four ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Zengel abstained as he was not present for the complete reading of the minutes.

At this point, Councilman Stingley entered the meeting.

The council reviewed and discussed the plat plan for Pleasant Hill Plat, Section 7. Action was deferred until a later meeting.

Mr. Wiseman read Ordinance 6-62 amending Ordinance 16 dated November 30, 1959. This is an ordinance regulating the parking of trucks, tractors and trailers on the streets of the Village of Centerville.

Mr. Sims sponsored Ordinance 6-62.

Mr. Griest moved that Ordinance 6-62 be given its first reading. Mr. Knierer seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Wiseman read Ordinance 6-62.

Mr. Stingley moved to accept the first reading of Ordinance 6-62. Mr. Knierer seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Sims, Chairman of the Police Committee, announced the following as annual salaries for the Police Department:

Marshall James Smith	\$5,750.00
Deputy Marshall Darrell Conley	4,900.00
Patrolman Clifford Kountz	4,600.00
Patrolman Everett Manning	4,800.00

These salaries are effective March 1, 1962 and are in accord with Ordinance 4-62 which fixes salary ranges for the Police Department.

Mr. Sims moved that Resolution 1-62 be passed. Mr. Griest seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Resolution 1-62 is a resolution to charge \$5.00 for each ambulance call made by the Village of Centerville, plus \$3.00 for each container of oxygen used and should a member of the Police Department operate the ambulance while off duty, such patrolman will be paid \$3.50 per ambulance run.

Mr. Griest moved that Resolution 2-62 be passed and that the expenditure of \$442.90 in connection with the resolution be approved. Mr. Theiss seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Resolution 2-62 is a resolution dealing with the improvement, under the

supervision of the State Director of Highways, of certain State roads within the limits of the Village of Centerville.

Mr. Griest gave a street report.

The meeting was adjourned.
