

Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio, met in special session with Mayor William Gimbel presiding April 18, 1962 at 7:30 P.M. Present were councilmen Clarence Stingley, John Zengel, Richard Knierer, Wilbur Sims and John Theiss, Solicitor William Wiseman and Engineer Frank Williams.

Mr. John Theiss acted as clerk and took minutes of the meeting.

Mr. Richard Knierer read the minutes of the Street Committee meeting of April 9, 1962.

Mr. Sims moved that the Street Committee report be accepted and that the council advertise for bids for sealing the streets in the Village. The bid will specify that RT 10 and No. 6 crushed stone will be used and the minimum expenditure will be \$10,000.00. Mr. Stingley seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Knierer sponsored Ordinance 7-1962. This is an ordinance to locate certain stop signs in the Village of Centerville.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance 7-62 its first reading.

Mr. Sims moved that the first reading of Ordinance 7-62 be passed. Mr. Stingley seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Sims moved that the Statutory Rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinances on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ordinance 7-62 may be given its second and third reading by title only. Mr. Knierer seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance 7-62 its second reading by title only.

Mr. Sims moved that the second reading of Ordinance 7-62 be accepted. Mr. Stingley seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion.

Mayor Gimbel gave Ordinance 7-62 its third reading by title only.

Mr. Sims moved that Ordinance 7-62 be passed as read. Mr. Zengel seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in five ayes in favor of the motion.

Engineer Frank Williams presented subdivision costs on Black and Combs plat, Section 2. The estimates were returned to the engineer for inclusion of costs of the sidewalks to the school.

The meeting was adjourned.
