Sims moved that the council instruct the solicitor to prepare a zoning ordinance in accordance with the zoning as recommended by the Planning Board. Mr. Zengel seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Theiss reported for the Planning Board. Mr. Theiss read the Planning Board meeting minutes of October 10, 1962, October 22, 1962 and November 13, 1962.

Mr. Griest reported for the Street Committee. Mr. Griest moved that the performance bond on Concept Plat Section 6 be reduced to \$15,000 and the performance bond on Concept Plat, Section 7 be reduced to \$13,500. Mr. Stingley seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in six ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Griest moved that the performance bond on Black & Combs Lynn Rae
