Regular Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session with Mayor Gimbel presiding, July 3, 1961. Present: Walter Rhoades, Richard Knierer, John Theiss, Dr. Kelso. Solicitor Anthony Lair, Engineer Frank Williams.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. It was moved by Mr. Rhoades, seconded by Mr. Theiss and carried that the minutes be approved. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion.

The Mayor's report of Local Fines and Forfeitures amounting to \$1006.00, Certificate of Occupancy amounting to \$1.00, Zoning Permits amounting to \$60.00 showing that the same had been paid in the Village Treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Theiss, seconded by Mr. Rhoades and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion.

The 1962 budget was then presented to the Council. It was moved by Mr. Rhoades to accept the Budget Committees report, seconded by Mr. Theiss. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion.

The Publication for the improvement of East Drive was made on June 13 and June 20. The bids were to be opened June 24, 1961 at 12:00 noon.

Since no bids were received at this time no action can be taken.

Mr. Knierer, Chairman of the St. Committee, asked permission of the Council for readvertising for bids on East Drive and to extend the work to be done to Laura Ave. After general discussion it was decided by the Council to table this matter until the property owners on East Drive have been contacted. Mr. Knierer also reported that the land owners shall pay for the curb and gutter fronting their properties at the rate of \$1.60 per foot.

The Village Engineer talked about a detailed storm sewer drainage survey especially in the older part of Centerville where no storm sewers are at present.

Mr. Knierer then moved to authorize to spend up to \$1000.00 for the Village Engineer to make a preliminary survey of a storm sewer drainage study, seconded by Mr. Theiss and carried. A roll resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion.

Thereupon Mr. Rhoades introduced Ord. 12-61 being "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance # 16,1959 as it relates to the speed of motor vehicles under section 24.2," Dr. Kelso made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ord. on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 12-61 may be given its second reading," seconded by Mr Theiss and carried. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion. Then Ord. 12-61 was given its second reading. Dr. Kelso then made the following motion "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolution and Ord. on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 12-61 may be given its third reading," seconded by Mr. Theiss. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion. The Ord. 12-61 was given its third reading. The question being shall Ord. 12-61 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Rhoades, seconded by Mr. Theias and carried. A roll call resulted as follows: Dr. Kelso, aye; Mr. Theiss, aye; Mr. Rhoades, aye; Mr. Knierer, aye.

Mr. Theiss, Chairman of the Planning Board read the minutes of the June 13,1961 Planning Meeting.

The meeting adjourned.
