The Mayor then duly swore in Howard Griest as Council-

man.

The Mayor then read a letter from the County Commissioners office, pretaining to the re-advertisement for bids for the sale of .25 acres of ground belonging to the water works. Bids are to be received by Sept. 19.1961.

Also a letter from the County Budget Commission pretaining to the budget hearing for the Village of Centerville Sept. 11,1961.

Mr. Knierer, Chairman of the St. Committee, reported of the Engineers approval of the 1st three streets of Concept Development, also a list of approved repavement of sewer **kkxexek** trenches that were filled in.

The Council authorized the Clerk to return the money on the following permits. (1) 61-4 77 Laura Ave. (2) 61-15 53 South -

Main (3) 61-37 33 South Main St. (4) 61-39 80 Martha Ave. (5) 61-40 54 Martha Ave. (6) 61-41 62 Martha Ave. (7) 61-44 61 Martha Ave. (8) 61-48 38 Martha Ave.

Mr. Knierer disscussed the present weed Ord. whereby weeds will be cut by Sept. 15,1901 of each year, this is too late because of the weeds have already went to seed. Mr. Knierer recommends this Ord. should be changed to Aug. 15.

The Council then authorized the Solicitor to redraw up the weed Ord. whereby the weeds shall be cut by Aug. 15 of each year.

Mr. Theiss, Chairman of the Planning Board read the last Planning Boards minutes. The Planning Board received the revised copy of the Centerville Zoning Ord. and Maps Sept. 1,1961 and the Planning Board then approved the revised Ord. and Maps as presented. Mr. Theiss then presented the Council with the Zoning Ord. and Maps for their approval. After general discussion the Council then placed on file with the Clerk-Treas. the Zoning Ord. and Maps. (Sept. 5,1961)

Mr. Sims then moved to set a Public Hearing for the re- *Oct 12,1961 at B30 PM*. vised Zoning Ord. of the Village of Centerville, seconded by Mr. Theiss. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes and 2 nayes. Mr. Rhondes and Mr. Knierer voted naye on the grounds the Council has never accepted the revised Zoning Ord. or Maps. The motion carried.

It was then moved by Mr. Rhoades, seconded by Mr. Griest to pass Resoution #2-61 "Resoulution designating public depository and awarding public monies pursuant to the uniform depository act of.Ohio, by the Village of Centerville, Ohio" A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.
