The Clerk-Treas. received and placed on file the transcript proceeding of the board of County Commissioners in the matter of the proposed annexation of certain territories to the Village of Centerville containing approximately 1098.65 acres, Sept. 25,1961.

The streets in Concept Section 1,2,3, & 4 were inspected and reported that there was a lot of repair work to be done before being accepted.

The Council instructed the Engineer to make up a list of work to be done on these streets and contact the developer and have the streets repaired before the winter sets in.

Complaints by citizens living in Washington Park as to speeding on Morth Main Street and the trouble of getting their children
across Rt. 48 to school since it has been widened, were discussed
by the Council. It was the Council's decision to have the Solicitor
to write the State Highway Dept. and find out what can be done to
control the traffic on the West side of Rt. 48 since it is not in
the Village Corporation.
