

Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in a special meeting March 21, 1960 with Mayor Gimbel presiding. Present: Richard Knierer, Dr. Kelso, George Niswonger, Robert Tamaska, Wilbur Sims of the Councilmen. Solicitor Anthony Lair, Engineer Frank Williams.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. It was moved by Mr. Tamaska, seconded by Mr. Sims and carried that the minutes be approved. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

The purpose of this special meeting is to take action on the three items of the agenda set for this meeting.

(1) Pleasant Hill Plat, Section #5. It was moved by Mr. Niswonger to accept the performance bond of \$89,220.80, also sub dividers agreement and the dedication of the streets of Pleasant Hill Plat Section #5, according to the Engineers recommendation, seconded by Mr. Tamaska and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

(2) Ordinance 10-60 was given its' second reading.

(3) Victory Construction Co. It was moved by Mr. Knierer to reduce the cash bond of \$5000.00 that Victory Construction Co. has posted with the Village Treasury, to the amount of \$1000.00. Refunding \$4000.00 of the \$5000.00 cash bond, according to the Engineers recommendation, seconded by Mr. Sims and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.
