

Regular Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session with Mayor William Gimbel presiding, April 4, 1960. Present: Dr. Kelso, Robert Tamaska, Wilbur Sims, George Niswonger, Richard Knierer, Walter Rhoades of the Councilmen. Solicitor Anthony Lair, Engineer Frank Williams.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. It was moved by Mr. Niswonger, seconded by Mr. Tamaska and carried that the minutes be approved. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Rhoades abstained.

The Mayor's report of Local Fines and Forfeitures amounting to \$351.70, Building Permits amounting to \$171.00, Certificate of Occupancy amounting to \$8.00 showing that the same had been paid in the Village Treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Sims, seconded by Dr. Kelso and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Knierer, seconded by Mr. Niswonger that the following bills be approved for payment.

The Mayor read a letter from Judge Vogt, of Kettering court.

It was moved by Dr. Kelso the Village accepts no responsibilities for the proscution of the case of the State of Ohio VS. Juanita R. Denlinger, seconded by Mr. Rhoades and carried. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes in favor and 2 naves. The motion carried. The Council then instructed the Solicitor to write a letter to Judge Vogt advising him of the Councils action.

The Planning Commission read their minutes of March 29, 1960 meeting also read their report of the public hearing they held April 1, 1960 pretaining to an "Additional Land Use Permit" for the Quarry Lake. The Solicitor then read the prepared additional land use permit.

It was moved by Mr. Sims that the "Additional Land Use Permit" be granted to Mr. Boggs and Mr. Harris, seconded by Mr. Niswonger and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

The Street Committee asked the Council to advertise for bids for Street repair work and sealing of the streets.

The Council then advised the Street Committee to decide what street work is to be done and advertise for bids.

Ord. 10-60 "An Ordinance amending Ordinance 16-59, Section 284" was given its' third reading. It was moved by Mr. Tamaska to pass Ord. 10-60, seconded by Mr. Sims and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Thereupon, Mr. Rhoades introduced Ord. 11-60, being "An emergency Ordinance enacted by the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio in the matter of the hereinafter described improvement, under the supervision of the Director of Highways pretaining to Main Street Route 48," Mr. Tamaska made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinance on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 11-60 may be given its seconded and third readings," seconded by Dr. Kelso

and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. Then Ord. 11-60 was given its seconded and third readings. The question being, Shall Ord. 11-60 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Tamaska, seconded by Mr. Rhodes and carried. A roll call resulted as follows: Mr. Sims, aye; Mr. Niswonger, aye; Dr. Kelso, aye; Mr. Rhoades, aye; Mr. Tamaska, aye; Mr. Knierer, aye; This Ordinance was passed as an emergency measure.

Thereupon, Mr. Knierer introduced Ord. 12-60, being "An Ordinance establishing certain stop streets in the Village of Centerville, Ohio." Mr. Niswonger made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinance on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 12-60 may be given its seconded and third readings," seconded by Dr. Kelso and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. Then Ord. 12-60 was given its seconded and third readings. The question being, Shall Ord. 12-60 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Tamaska, seconded by Mr. Sims and carried. A roll call resulted as follows: Dr. Kelso, aye; Mr. Knierer, aye; Mr. Rhoades, aye; Mr. Tamaska, aye; Mr. Sims, aye; Mr. Niswonger, aye. This Ordinance was passed as an emergency measure.

The meeting adjourned.
