Regular Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session with Mayor Gimbel presiding, July 11, 1960. Present: Richard Knierer, Robert Tamaska, Dr. Kelso, George Niswonger, Wilbur Sims, Walter Rhoades of the Councilmen. Solicitor Anthony Lair, Engineer Frank Williams.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved. It was moved by Mr. Tamaska, seconded by Mr. Niswonger and carried that the minutes be approved. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

The Mayor then read a letter from Mr. Welsch of Kettering pretaining to hiring a Traffic Engineer on a cost basis. The Council decided that when they felt it was necessary to hire one they would let Mr. Welsch know of their intension. Also a letter from James T. Lynn on behalf of Mr. Cultiee for rezoning. This letter was a letter of withdrawl of an appliciation change of zoning filed Feb. 1960 in accord with article XX1 Section 2 of the Ammended zoning Ord. of 1955.

Also a letter from Carl Bauer, County Engineer in reply of the letter the Mayor wrote him pretaining to t he maintance of East Franklin St. at certain postions.

The transcript of annexation pretaining to the Lloyd Hibberd property was prestented to the Council.

Ord. 13-60 "An Ord to regulate the price rate which the Dayton Power & Light Co., its successors and assigns, may charge for natural gas in the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, during the period of two (2) years, commencing on the effective date of this Ordinance." was given its 3rd reading. It was moved by Mr. Rhoades that Ord. 13-60 be passed, seconded by Mr. Sims and carried. A roll

call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Thereupon, Mr. Sims introduced Ord. 15-60, being "An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 14, 1960, section 5, of the Village of Centerville, Ohio appointing a Village Deputy Marshal." Mr. Rhoades made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinance on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 15-60 may be given its seconded and third readings," seconded by Mr. Tamaska and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. Then Ord. 15-60 was given its seconded and third readings. The question being, Shall Ord. 15-60 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Sims, seconded by Mr. Rhoades and carried. A roll call resulted as follows: Dr. Kelso, aye; Mr. Knierer, aye; Mr. Rhoades, aye; Mr. Tamaska, aye; Mr. Sims, aye; Mr. Niswonger, aye. This Ordinance was passed as an emergency measure.

Mr. Knierer of the St. Committee reported on East Drive, and told of the Engineer^{inc} work to be done. It was the Councils agreement that the Engineer^{inc} work shall be done.

The discussion of purchasing a snow plow followed. It was moved by Mr. Knierer to buy a Gledhill 10TRW-BA snowplow at the cost of \$700.00, seconded by Mr. Tamaska and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

The 1961 budget was then presented to the Council. It was moved by Mr. Rhoades to accept the Budget Committees report, seconded by Dr. Kelso. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Tamaska to accept the Ohio Bell Telephone Co. project 16553, seconded by Mr. Sims and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Niswonger read the minutes of the past Planning Commission meetings.

Professor Francis McGovern of the University of Dayton of Economics Research Center introduced Mr. Harry Sheridan, president of the Metropolitan Planners Inc. of Indianapolis, who explained the outline of the "Master Plan" of long range planning. For THE VILLAGE OF CENT.¹⁰
