Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in a Special Meeting Nov. 21, 1960 with Mayor Gimbel presiding. Present: Mr. Knierer, Mr. Rhoades, Mr. Sims, Mr. Tamaska, Mr. Niswonger of the Councilmen. Dr. Kelso came in late. Engineer, Frank Williams, Solicitor Anthony Lair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. It was moved by Mr. Tamaska, seconded by Mr. Niswonger and carried that the minutes be approved. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Rhoades to pass Resoulution #2 -1960 "A resolution affirming the transfer of \$7,000.00 from C2 General Fund to H4 Street Maintenance and Repair Fund, ~~and transferring \$300.00 from C2 General Fund to H4 Street Maintenance and Repair Fund~~ for the purpose of paying for street repair." Seconded by Mr. Knierer and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was then moved by Mr. Rhoades to "accept the Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor," seconded by Mr. Tamaska and carried.
