It was then moved by Mr. Rhoades to "accept the Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor," seconded by Mr. Tamaska and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Discussion concerning the combining of the Village and Township Police took place. Mr. Sims then moved to accept the agreement of the Police proposal. After more discussion, Mr. Sims moved to withdraw his motion, seconded by Dr. Kelso and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

The Mayor then appointed Mr. Knierer as President Pro-tem of the Council.
