

The Council members immediately called another special meeting upon the adjournment of the previous meeting. The purpose of this meeting pertains to the Son Development Company, Section 3, Plat 3, in which the Council asked for side walks on Virginia Drive. After a general discussion it was moved by Mr. Neubauer that the Subdivider's Agreement and Performance Bond of Section 3, Plat 3, of Son Development Co. and the dedication of streets in that section be approved and accepted subject to the installation of a sidewalk, the specifications for which will be approved by the Village Council to be located on the east or west side of Virginia Ave., the side to be designated by the Village Council and to extend between the boundaries of Section 3. This requirement shall be incorporated in the documents above in a manner to be approved by the Village solicitor and Village engineer upon such approval and such incorporation the Performance Bond and Subdivider's Agreement shall be signed by a ministerial act. The ~~discussion~~<sup>decision</sup> by the Council concerning the side of the street on which the sidewalk shall be laid shall be made no later than the regular meeting Sept 1959.
