Solicitor Lynn read a letter to the Council from Mr.

Packard who is representing Davis Oil Co. of the action they intend to take against the Village of Centerville if a Building Permit was not granted.

The Council then directed the Solicitor to write the owners of the ground where the proposed station is to be errected and have them either bulldoze the holes shut or errect a barricade around these holes so to due away with the hazard that now exists.
