Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met for a Special Meeting, Nov. 23, 1959 with Mayor Jackson presiding. Present: Councilmen Bernard Cramer, Richard Neal, Walter Rhoades, Frank Arnold, and Rol Cultice. Solicitor James Lynn & Mr. Thiele.

It was moved by Mr. Neal to adopt the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies to certifying them to the County Auditor, seconded by Mr. Cramer. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

After the Village Clerk informed the Council pertaining to monies posted for bond in accordance to Ord. 13-59 and of the discussion that took place with the Village Depository about the placing of these funds in a savings account which was passed as a motion in the Nov. 2, 1959 regular meeting, it was moved by Mr. Rhoades to ~~recede~~ the motion of Nov. 2, 1959 pertaining to the handling of these funds, seconded by Mr. Cultice. A roll call resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion.

A discussion took place by the Council pertaining to the handling of all traffic violation in the Village of Centerville beginning the year of 1960 as to whether the Kettering Court shall handle these cases in their court. It was then determined by the Council that this matter should be decided by the incoming Council.

Thereupon, Mr. Neal introduced Ord. 16-59 "A Codification Ord." Mr. Arnold made the following motion, "I move the statutory rules and regulation for reading Resolution and Ordinance on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 16-59 may be given its second and 3rd reading," seconded by Mr. Cramer. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion. The Village Solicitor then proceeded with reading of the Ord. until the Council agreed to adjourn. A Special Meeting was set for Nov. 30, 1959 at 7:00 P.M. for the purpose of finishing reading of the Ord.
