**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 268,
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION,
OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 268 of the Centerville Municipal Code established the Parks and Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Centerville Section 9.01 gives City Council the authority by Ordinance to create all Boards and Commissions deemed necessary or desirable for the most efficient functioning of the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Centerville, Section 9.02 gives the City Council the authority to abolish Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that there is not an active Parks and Recreation Commission and thus, no need to have such a commission; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to formally take action to abolish Chapter 268 of the Centerville Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 268, Parks and Recreation Commission, of the Centerville Municipal Code shall be repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
