RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES WITH DONALD J. SCHONHARDT & ASSOCIATES TO UPDATE AUTOMATED FIXED ASSET SYSTEMS FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is desirous of obtaining professional consulting services to assist the City's Director of Finance with updating the current fixed asset inventory and documentation of the proper fixed asset policies and procedures for the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to seek assistance in assisting in the carrying out of activities including, but not limited to, review existing fixed asset inventory listings, preparing a comprehensive fixed asset policy and procedures and assist in implantation of software system; and

WHEREAS, Donald J. Schonhardt & Associates has unique knowledge of municipal governments and a demonstrated ability to assist in accomplishing the objectives of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City hereby agrees to enter into an Agreement with Donald J. Schonhardt & Associates and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement with Donald J. Schonhardt & Associates in a form substantially similar to the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein on behalf of the City of Centerville.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
