A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY L.J. DEWEESE CO. INC. OF TIPP CITY, OHIO FOR THE 2019 PEDESTRIAN RAILING REPLACEMENT PROJECT (PROJECT SS-1) FOR REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING BRIDGE AND CULVERT RAILINGS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bids for the 2019 Pedestrian Railing Replacement according to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, L.J. DeWeese Co. Inc. of Tipp City, Ohio, was the low and best bidder.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by L.J. DeWeese Co. Inc. of Tipp City, Ohio for the 2019 Pedestrian Railing Replacement (Project SS-1), is hereby accepted in the amount of \$76,455.00. The City Manager is hereby authorized to expend up to an additional \$7,645.00 for additional work if necessary, making the total amount approved \$84,100.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to execute a contract with L.J. DeWeese Co. Inc. of Tipp City, Ohio, as stated above.


Section 3. This resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
