A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY BELGRAY, INC. OF WILMINGTON, OHIO FOR THE 2018 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PROJECT SS-1) FOR SIGNAL REPLACEMENT AND MEDIAN RELOCATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bids for the 2018 Intersection Improvements Project according to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, **Belgray, Inc. of Wilmington, Ohio**, was the low and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by **Belgray, Inc. of Wilmington, Ohio** for the 2018 Intersection Improvements Project (Project SS-1), is hereby accepted in the amount of \$239,932.00. The City Manager is hereby authorized to expend up to an additional \$23,993.20 for additional work if necessary, making the total amount approved \$263,925.20.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to execute a contract with **Belgray, Inc. of Wilmington, Ohio**, as stated above.


Section 3. This resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
