A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION'S (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, The State Capital Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville is planning to make capital improvements to the public infrastructure of the Forest Brook Blvd ditch and culverts; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein described are considered to be a priority need for the community and are qualified under the OPWC programs.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
