A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY DOUBLE JAY CONSTRUCTION, INC. OF ENGLEWOOD, OHIO FOR THE CORNERSTONE OF CENTERVILLE, NORTH ON-SITE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE 4 STORM AND SANITARY FOR BROWN ROAD OUTLET (DEVELOPER FUNDED ESCROW) FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CORNERSTONE OF CENTERVILLE DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bids for the **Rebid - Cornerstone North of Centerville, On-Site Public Improvements –Phase 4 Storm & Sanitary for Brown Road Outlet** according to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, **Double Jay Construction, Inc. of Englewood, Ohio**, was the low and best bidder.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by **Double Jay Construction, Inc. of Englewood, Ohio** for the **Rebid -Cornerstone North of Centerville, On-Site Public Improvements –Phase 4 Storm & Sanitary for Brown Road Outlet** (Developer Funded Escrow), is hereby accepted in the amount of \$438,735.00. The City Manager is hereby authorized to expend up to an additional \$43,873.00 for additional work if necessary, making the total amount approved \$482,608.00.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to execute a contract with **Double Jay Construction, Inc. of Englewood, Ohio**, as stated above.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
