A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ADVANCES OUT OF THE CURRENT COLLECTION OF REAL ESTATE, PERSONAL PROPERTY AND ESTATE TAXES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that municipal corporations may request the County Auditor to make advance payments of collected taxes; and

WHEREAS, it is the legislative determination of this Council that because of limited carryover balances, such advance payments would be in the best interest of the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The City of Centerville hereby requests the Auditor of Montgomery County, Ohio to issue his warrant upon the Montgomery County Treasurer in favor of the City of Centerville of the current collection of real estate, personal property and estate taxes assessed and collected for and on behalf of the City of Centerville, which sum shall be held and treated as an advance payment on the current collection of taxes due the City of Centerville on the date next ensuing after the date of this Resolution. The entire advance shall be allocated to the General Fund.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to accept said warrant on behalf of the City of Centerville.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This resolution becomes effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
