A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE RECYCLING CONTAMINATION GRANT **PROGRAM** AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO ALLOW THE CITY TO PARTICIPATE WITH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISTRICT TO PREPARE **SUBMIT PROPOSAL** FOR THE RECYCLING AND A CONTAMINATION GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) and The Recycling Partnership, a national nonprofit, have partnered on a grant application process to improve the quality of recyclables in light of today's market conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is committed to providing curbside recycling service to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville intends to support and cooperate with the Montgomery County Solid Waste District to apply for grant funds to engage with residents to improve curbside recycling behavior to further reduce contamination in the recycling stream.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the City of Centerville hereby supports and desires to participate in the OEPA and The Recycling Partnership grant program.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to have the City partner with Montgomery County Solid Waste District on the application for the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Recycling Contamination Grant Program, as described above.

SECTION 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
