

RESOLUTION NO. 24-17
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Bill Serr ON
THE 15th DAY OF May, 2017.

A RESOLUTION AGREEING THAT THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE SHOULD CONTINUE PARTICIPATION IN THE UNITED WAY OF THE GREATER DAYTON AREA'S SENIORLINK AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO COMMIT FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000 TO PARTICIPATE FOR AN ADDITIONAL ONE YEAR PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the United Way of Greater Dayton Area has created the SeniorLink initiative to assist seniors in the community with access to available services that allow Seniors greater independence, mobility and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the SeniorLink core technology is the United Way's Helplink 2-1-1, which reaches more than 700,000 people; and

WHEREAS, the SeniorLink initiatives are 1). to increase awareness and overall support for senior citizens, 2). to educate more people of the available and relevant services and opportunities for current and emerging senior needs, 3). to streamline efficient systems providing real-time access to information and services, and 4). to identify service gaps; and

WHEREAS, the initial goal of SeniorLink was to launch the program in three cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville was one of the initial cities invited to participate; and

WHEREAS, the program has benefited the citizens of Centerville and is now being expanded due to additional cities participating.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City of Centerville agrees to continue its participation in the United Way of Dayton Area's SeniorLink Initiative and agrees to commit up to \$5,000 for the City's commitment and participation in the program as requested for the coming year. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to allow the City to continue participation in the program.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
