AMENDMENT TO CHIEF OF POLICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into at Centerville, Ohio, on the ____ day of _____, by and between the City of Centerville, an Ohio municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and Bruce P. Robertson (hereinafter "Chief of Police").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. _____, passed by a majority vote of all members of the Council of the City of Centerville on the ____ day of _____, the CHIEF OF POLICE AGREEMENT authorized by Resolution 29-14 is hereby authorized to be amended in accordance with the provisions below; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend Section 2 Term of Employment and Section 6 Compensation of said Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitations and pursuant to the terms of Resolution No. _____, the parties agree as follows with the matter to be omitted shown by ~~strike-out~~ and the new matter shown by *italics*:

Section 1. That effective _____, Section 2 Term of Employment of said Agreement is amended to read as follows:

"This Agreement shall commence on October 27, 2014 and shall ~~be for a term of three (3) years~~ *end on January 6, 2019* unless terminated as provided herein. The Employee shall serve at the pleasure of the City Manager as an "at will" employee."

Section 2. That effective _____, Section 6 Compensation of said Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“ In consideration of the performance of all services required by the City, the City shall provide Employee an annual salary of One Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand, Three Hundred Forty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$122,345.00), which shall remain unchanged ~~for a period of three (3) years.~~ Payment less all applicable taxes and deductions shall be made in accordance with the City pay schedule currently consisting of twenty-six (26) pay periods per year.”

Section 3. In all other respects said Agreement shall remain in full force as written.

Section 4. That in all other respects said existing CHIEF OF POLICE AGREEMENT, as amended is hereby ratified and restated as if fully rewritten herein.
