

RESOLUTION NO. 59-17
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER John Palcher ON THE 16th

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACTIONS TO MAKE AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL FAST ACT FUNDS THROUGH THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE RESURFACING OF WILMINGTON PIKE FROM ALEX-BELL ROAD (SR725) TO NORTH OF I-675 AND TO RATIFY THE CITY MANAGER'S ACTIONS TO ENTER INTO A PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE GREENE COUNTY ENGINEER.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville, committed to maintaining existing thoroughfares in the City of Centerville, recognizes the need for Wilmington Pike to be resurfaced, and

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) has solicited local government entities to submit new transportation projects for funding consideration in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville and Greene County have entered into a cost sharing agreement for this project to cover the local share of expenses in their respective jurisdictions for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has committed to a timely project development schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville will commit the necessary resources to support the estimated local cost portion of the following described project to be submitted to MVRPC:

1. Wilmington Pike Resurfacing Project –Estimated Local Share \$792,317. Centerville portion would be \$572,179 and Greene County portion would be \$220,138 (Wilmington Pike Resurfacing Project); and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville requests exemptions from MVRPS's Complete Streets Policy for the proposed project funding applications:

1. Wilmington Pike Resurfacing Project (Exemption 4) – Where the project consist of maintenance, repair or resurfacing of an existing cross-section only (Cyclist and pedestrian exemption); and

WHEREAS, A Federal Fund Application has been submitted to the MVRPC for Federal STP-Resurfacing Funds for the resurfacing of Wilmington Pike from Alex-Bell Road (SR725) to 700 feet north of I-675 for a total distance of 1.416 miles.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. This Resolution shall serve to ratify and authorize the transmittal and submittal of the application for the following transportation project to MVRPC for funding consideration in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP):

1. Wilmington Pike Resurfacing Project

Section 2. The City Manager's actions in signing on behalf of the City the application for funds as referred to in Section I of the Resolution is hereby ratified.


Section 3. The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to take or cause to be taken all other action necessary and proper to secure the funding sought by the application referred to herein, and provide any additional information sought by the reviewing agencies during the time the application is under review. The City Manager is further directed and authorized to cause compliance with all reporting requirements required by the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) as required as part of the funding process.

Section 4. Upon application approval, the City hereby states its commitment to the local contribution for the project as identified in this application, including local contribution of cost exceeding the current estimates or subsequent revised estimates as accepted by the MVRPC. The City Manager's action in executing the Project Agreement with the Greene County Engineer is hereby ratified and a true copy of the agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".



EXHIBIT A

PROJECT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GREENE COUNTY ENGINEER AND THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE

This Agreement between the Greene County Engineer (hereinafter referred to as the "Engineer"), and the City of Centerville (hereinafter referred to as the "City") is made this _____ day of _____, 2017. The Engineer and City's purpose to enter into an Agreement is for road improvements on Wilmington Pike.

1. The Engineer and City agree to pay their local share of all work in their respective jurisdiction. Estimated Greene County Share – \$220,138. Items will be paid at unit prices as specified in the bid. Estimated City of Centerville Share – \$572,179. Items will be paid at unit prices as specified in the bid.


2. Each respective jurisdictions/Representative(s), shall decide all questions which may arise as to quality and acceptability of materials furnished and work performed and as to the rate of progress of the work; all questions which may arise as to the interpretation of the plans and specifications; all questions as to the acceptable fulfillment of the contract on the part of the Contractor, and as to compensation.

3. The County Engineer shall review any designs involving County jurisdiction made by an engineer employed for the project. His approval must be obtained before the project is advertised for bids.

4. As the Engineer and City have agreed to cooperate on this project, the contractor shall invoice the City for the completed work; in turn the City shall invoice the Engineer for its respective portion of work.
