A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT
A BID FOR A LEAF VACUUM AT A FUTURE DATE IN AN
AMOUNT UP TO \$65,000.

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville has the purchase of a leaf vacuum in its
Capital Improvement Budget for 2015 and has been deemed eligible for a Montgomery
County Solid Waste District Incentive grant to help fund this piece of equipment; and

WHEREAS, in order to utilize the grant funds available, the City needs to
purchase the leaf vacuum as soon as possible, and

WHEREAS, specifications for the leaf vacuum have been prepared by the Public
Works Department, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Centerville to authorize the
purchase of the leaf vacuum in an amount not to exceed \$65,000; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. Following standard bidding procedures, the City Manager is hereby
authorized to accept the lowest and best bid for the leaf vacuum, for a bid amount up to
\$65,000, at his discretion in the best interests of the City.

Section 2. This resolution is to take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
