A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATIONS FOR SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL (SRTS) PROGRAM FUNDING TO IMPLEMENT THE CENTERVILLE SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside funds for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Projects and local public agencies can apply for these funds and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, SRTS is a federal, state and local effort to encourage children in grades K-8, including those with disabilities, to walk and bicycle to school and to make walking and bicycling to schools safe and appealing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville adopted a School Travel Plan in order to apply for funds through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation to implement the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville proposes to construct or reconstruct school zone signal flashes for Stingley Elementary, Cline Elementary, and Magsig Middle School as recommended in the School Travel Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville is required by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation to endorse applications for Safe Routes to School funds;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Council of the City of Centerville hereby endorses applications for Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS) Program funding to construct or reconstruct school zone signal flashes for Stingley Elementary, Cline Elementary, and Magsig Middle School.

<u>Section 2:</u> This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
