A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND DOUBLE JAY CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR CENTERVILLE GATEWAY ENHANCEMENTS, PHASE II, SS-9, AT I-675 AND STATE ROUTE 48.

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for enhancement of the interchange area to create a gateway to the area, including decorative fencing, stone columns and landscaping at the northeast quadrant of State Route 48 and Interstate 675, and

WHEREAS, project funding is a federal Transportation Enhancement grant for 80% of the construction cost, up to a maximum of \$110,720, with the remainder to be covered by private funding, and

WHEREAS, Double Jay Construction, Inc. was the lowest and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. That the bid submitted by Double Jay Construction, Inc., for Centerville Gateway Enhancements, Phase II, for the bid price of \$111,840.00 is hereby accepted, a copy of said bid is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to expend up to \$11,200.00 as a contingency, if additional work becomes necessary.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to execute a contract with Double Jay Construction, Inc., as stated above.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
