# RESOLUTION NO. 39-14 CITY OF CENTERVILLE

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER John Palcher ON THE 2014 DAY OF October, 2014.

A RESOLUTION ENACTED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE CITY, IN THE MATTER OF THE STATED DESCRIBED PROJECT, MOT SR 725 20.24, PID NO. 97667, FOR THE ODOT URBAN PAVING PROGRAM ON S.R. 725 (ALEX-BELL ROAD) FROM LOOP ROAD TO THE GREENE COUNTY LINE.

# **SECTION 1. Project Description**

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Pavement planning and resurfacing of the existing pavement on State Route 725, Straight Line Mileage 20.24 to 22.31, within the City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio. Said project is further identified as MOT SR 725 20.24.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

#### SECTION II. Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the City gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

### **SECTION III.** Cooperation Statement

The City shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

ODOT will provide funding from its allocated Urban Paving Program funds on an eighty percent/twenty percent (80%/20%) basis with the State providing the eighty percent (80%) of the funding for the project and the City providing the twenty percent (20%) of the funding for the project.

The City agrees to pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

And further, if the City requests to perform any other work beyond the resurfacing treatment, the City shall assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the costs associated with those items.

# SECTION IV. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The City agrees that all right-of-way (if applicable) required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The City also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs. The City agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

#### SECTION V. Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the City shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C. Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and, (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

## SECTION VI. Authority to Sign

The City Manager of said City of Centerville is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Centerville to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

**SECTION VII.** That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
