A RESOLUTION ENACTED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY (LPA), IN THE MATTER OF THE STATED DESCRIBED PROJECT, MOT/CLA GUIDE SIGN REPLACEMENT, PID NO. 87931.

SECTION 1. Project Description
WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

To replace Systematic Guide Signs on the Mainline and Ramps in Montgomery County on Interstate 675 (Straight Line Mileage 0.00 to Straight Line Mileage 7.44) from Interstate 75 to the Greene County Line, plus or minus, in Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio. Said project is further identified as MOT/CLA Guide Sign Replacement.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION II. Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the City of Centerville gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III. Cooperation Statement

The City of Centerville shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The CITY of Centerville has no obligation for costs for the project as described in Section I. ODOT will provide all Federal-aid and State funds as set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U. S. Department of Transportation.

SECTION IV. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The CITY of Centerville agrees that all right-of-way (if applicable) required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The CITY also understands that right-ofway costs include eligible utility costs. The CITY agrees to be responsible for all utility accommodation, relocation, and reimbursement and will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V. Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the ODOT shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C. Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and, (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI. Authority to Sign

The City Manager of said City of Centerville is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Centerville to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION VII. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
