A RESOLUTION ENDORSING "PROJECT 1000 CHERRY TREES" WITHIN THE AREA OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE US AIR FORCE.
WHEREAS, the Greater Dayton Area is the home of Wright-Patterson Air Force Base which participated in relief efforts following the earthquake and tsunami that devastated northeast Japan on March 11, 2011, and
WHEREAS, "Operation 1000 Cherry Trees" proposes to plant 1000 trees to memorialize those who perished, those who have suffered, and those who have come to the aid of Japan.
WHEREAS, the City of Centerville wishes to support the creation of this 3-11 Memorial Park as proposed by Japanese Americans who live and work in the Dayton area and who hope to remember those who perished in the disaster as well as express gratitude for the aid received from the men and women of the Armed Forces of the United States and the American people, and
NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:
Section 1. That the City of Centerville supports the establishment of a 3-11 Memorial Park and endorses the efforts of Alex Hara, the organizer of the project.
Section 2. That the City of Centerville supports the request to use land at The National Museum of the Air Force.
Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective on the earliest date allowed by law.
