A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID
SUBMITTED BY SALEM OFFICE
PRODUCTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF
OFFICE FURNITURE FOR THE PUBLIC
WORKS CENTER OF THE CITY OF
CENTERVILLE AND TO RATIFY THE
ACTION OF THE CITY MANAGER IN
ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT IN
CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville issued a Request for Proposal for the purchase of a variety of office furniture for the Public Works Center according to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, Salem Office Products of Dayton, Ohio, was the low and best bidder and their proposal reflected State of Ohio pricing on a portion of the items proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Salem Office Products, for the purchase of office furniture for the Public Works Center for a proposal price of \$41,722.54 be accepted. It is requested that the contract amount include the revised proposal amount of \$42,092.92, plus an additional amount for contingency items for a total contract amount of \$43,500.00.

Section 2. That the Council hereby ratifies the action of the City Manager in executing a contract with Salem Office Products for the purchase of furniture as stated above, in order to assure timely delivery of the required furnishings.

Section 3. That this Resolution become effective on the earliest date allowed by law.
