A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR NEW FREEDOM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL **PLANNING** FOR COMMISSION PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE **IMPROVEMENTS** BENEFITING **AMERICANS** WITH DISABILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) has solicited local government entities and transit agencies to submit new transportation projects and/or services for funding consideration in the FY 2008 New Freedom Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has committed to a timely project development schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has committed the necessary resources to support the local cost portion of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1:

That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to submit applications to the MVRPC for 2008 New Freedom funding consideration from the Federal Transit Administration for the following transportation infrastructure projects to benefit Americans with Disabilities.

- 1. Loop Road Sidewalk Infill Project to construct 900' of sidewalk on the west side of Loop Road to provide access for riders of RTA Bus Route 14 to shopping, higher education/job training, professional offices and housing.
- 2. Pedestrian Pushbutton Accessibility Project to relocate pushbuttons at traffic signals to accessible locations along RTA Bus Routes 14, 16, 17 and 23.

Section 2:

This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
